

SAFETY


- Check to ensure that plans will meet local codes and guidelines


- Carpenter's Level

INSTALLATION

- Choose smooth, level site for Triple Shoot that is a safe distance from other structures.
- Dig hole for footer 18" wide and 12" deep (minimum).
- Set stakes in ground at 90° angles from each other a distance from the hole.
- Place pole in hole. Use bracing poles secured with zip ties to stabilize the pole.
- Use carpenter's level to ensure pole sits vertical. Check that pole height dimension is correct.
- Pour concrete and allow to cure for 48 hrs. minimum.
- Remove support poles and cover with desired fill material.
- Apply blue thread locking compound to pole threads and screw Triple Shoot in place.
